NEW GOALS

s a new organization established at the very end of 2019, Plumas Performing Arts was all set with its strategic plan for 2020 when the global coronavirus pandemic put a sudden end to most of the activities that make up our world. With students learning remotely, live concerts cancelled, and all the venues shut down, we threw away the old plan and came up with a new one.

2020's health, economic, social, and political crises touched us all in different ways, but each of us came away from the year with a new view about our world and new way of communicating our art. The mission of Plumas Performing Arts is to provide financial, organizational, and advocacy support for the performing arts. We met that mission through sponsoring online activities for students, assisting with instrument purchases, and providing grants for artists in our community to help them to continue practicing and performing at home.

2020 FUNDED ACTIVITIES

Plumas Performing Arts completed the following in 2020:

Remote Competition. In May 2020, Plumas Performing Arts stepped into the void caused by the global pandemic to replace several performing arts competitions that are typically held for high school and junior high school students. Students across the county submitted videos from home of their music and monologues. We recruited judges from

the greater region to review submissions, and awards were announced in June. PPA awarded competition winners with prizes ranging from \$250 for first place to \$25 for participating. Twenty three submissions were judged from students in Junior High and High School grades, helping to keep performing arts alive while students were studying remotely.

Instrument Purchases. We provided funding to Quincy Junior-Senior High School's music program to help get across the finish line with a year-long effort to raise funds to purchase a bassoon for the band program. In addition, at the request of a Plumas Unified School District music teacher, we purchased 25 ukuleles and tuners for sixth graders at Quincy Elementary School, which allowed for students across the county to learn ukulele remotely and in person with their fellow sixth graders.

Mini Grants. As the pandemic wore on through 2020, Plumas Performing Arts sponsored mini-grants of up to \$200 for both students and adults, to provide resources for lessons, instruments, gear, and other items to assist with learning and performing. Prior to the end of the year, we approved 12 mini-grants, with additional grants going into the beginning of 2021.

OUTLOOK FOR 2021

In 2021, Plumas Performing Arts will continue operating mostly as an on-line, remote organization, encouraging our teachers, students, artists, and musicians to continue their learning and performing at home and through virtual events. Performing arts activities are anticipated to be some of the last activities to come back to in-person experience, so we'll adjust our plans when there is more certainty about the public health situation for Plumas County, California.
